

### 18) H. S. C. Vocational Course:

### **Course Information:**

Present age is the age of Science and Technology. Rapid developments in Science and Engineering affect all walks of life today. Government and private enterprises offer a limited job opportunities. The best option today is to acquire the minimum knowledge, competency and start a small own business / enterprises. Self employment is the need of the hour.

Small and large Laboratories, Hospitals, Research Institutions, all use a range of machines and equipments. Almost every house today has T.V., Refrigerator, Fans, Geysers and Coolers etc. All these appliances need a Technical manpower for their maintenance and repair. Taking into consideration these facts, Government has started Minimum Competency Vocational Courses (M.C.V.C.). Students of these courses in two years (XI and XII) learn all the skills that would give the needed competency.

For the economically backward students these courses are a boon and passport for early earning capabilities. Our college is running these courses successfully since last 34 years.

### **■ Courses Available in Our College:**

- 1) Electronics Technology
- 2) Electrical Technology

Each course is of two years (XI and XII). On passing XII the H.S.S.C. Board gives Diploma of Technical Competency. A certificate is also given by Directorate of Vocational Education Maharashtra State.

### A) Further Education :

After passing H.S.S.C. (XII), M.C.V.C. students can join higher studies, they can go for B.Sc., B.A., B.Com, LL.B., Polytechnic courses, Girls students can join B.Sc. (Home Science) in our college.

M.C.V.C. passed student (in electronics / electrical) can get admission to B.Sc. 1st year in all groups except Biology group.

All above students will have to pass XIIth Mathematics during B.Sc. 1st year.

M.C.V.C. passed students in Fisheries and Agriculture can get admission to B.Sc. 1st year in Biology group. These students will have to pass XII Chemistry subject during B.Sc. 1st year. Electrical and Electronics students get admission directly to the 1st year of (B.Tech) degree in Electronics Engineering of Yeshwantrao

Chavan Maharashtra Open University (YCMOU). Our college is the study centre of YCMOU. Electrical students get license of 'Wireman' from Govt. of India with exemptions in the relevant examination.

### B) Employment Oppourtunities:

**General:** All the two Vocational Courses have been excellently designed for self employdment. Banks give loans to start workshop /repairing centre etc. District Industries Centre (DIC) provides guidance to M.C.V.C. students regarding self employment.

**Electronics Technology:** Course offers excellent opportunities in the field of self employment. Our past students are running successful T.V./Radio reapir shops. One of ex-students is considered among the best computer, printer repairer in Nagpur today. Industries in MIDC Nagpur employ XII M.C.V.C. passed students (Electronics) in large numbers.

**Electrical Technology:** Course provides an excellent opportunity for the students to become self employed in a short time and at a minimum cost. A large service sector in the field of electrical appliances repairing and rewinding has a large scope for

the Electrical Technicians. Electrical Appliances are becoming essential part of our life now. Naturally large technical manpower is required for maintenance and repair of all such Electrical Appliances. Many industries employ XII M.C.V.C. passed students as electricians and Electrical Technicians. Our ex-students are working as successful Electrical Contractors.

Electrical students get license of "Wireman" from Govt. of India with exemptions in the relevant examination.

### C) Industry Institute Linkage Committee:

There is an active linkage committee in the department. Ten organisations are the members of this Linkage Committee, which meet twice in a year. Student representatives of XII Std. participate in the meetings of the Linkage Committee. Every year many number of students find on-job training and Apprenticeship through this committee.

Edn. -1 Dt. 17.7.96, & Letter No. NSC/2002/126/ students attendance/PR/ MV/1/11505 Dt. 12.6.2002 of Director of Higher Education, Pune, must attend not less than 80% of the lectures (and practicals) in each of their subjects of study offered. Senior College students are required to fill in the Undertaking at the time of admission in the prescribed form given on page-13 duly countersigned by the Parent/Guardian. Students enrolled in N.C.C., N.S.S., Rotaract Club must put in 80% attendance and attend all camps in N.C.C. also.

Students who opt for Economically Backward Class Concession in fees, will have to submit the application in the prescribed format to the college within 30 Days from the Date of admission along with Income Certificate of their Parents for the financial year 2022-23. If students fail to submit the EBC form along with the necessary documents and those students whose EBC forms are rejected by the concerned Govt. Officials, will have to remit the full fees. Any mutilation or missing pages should be shown to the issuing clerk and a note regarding this should be taken. While returning the book, if it is found torn or mutilated, the student will be held responsible for that and he/she will have to replace the book or pay the amount of the book.
- iv) If the book is not returned within the due date, a fine at the rate of Re. 1/- per day will be charged.
- v) If the book is lost, the student, will have to replace the book or has to pay the cost of the book.
- vi) Students are not allowed to carry any belongings inside Reading Room and will have to show Identity Card to the Library Staff. Absolute silence is required to be maintained in Reading Room.
- vii) The Library staff is empowered to check any thing which a student intends to take outside the Library.
- viii) A latest Passport-size photograph is to be affixed on this Card. The photograph should be same as that affixed on Identity Card.

### B)Physical Efficiency Test: (PET

A Physical Efficiency Test is conducted once every year as per the Board / University rules. The test is compulsory for all the students except those participating in N.C.C. or N.S.S. or Intercollegiate games. A fine of Rs. 25/- will have to be paid for the absence at PET.

Principal can exempt students from the above activity on the following grounds only:- a) Age consideration (if it exceeds 26 years). b) Physical inability (for which a Certificate from the authorised Doctor appointed by the college is necessary).
